The AWP has been training teachers and college faculty to become Teacher Consultants since 2001. Once a teacher or college faculty member joins our network, his/her influence spreads far and wide to improve the teaching of writing in all content areas and in all levels. Each year, the AWP selects a group of experienced and talented individuals from all disciplines and all levels to attend the kickoff session, two week institute, and fall follow-up. Fellows share their writing and expertise and later work as consultants within our organization.

At the Summer Institute, fellows:

- Examine issues in the teaching of writing
- Improve the use of writing to deepen and extend learning in all curricular areas
- Present and demonstrate approaches to the teaching of writing
- Study current and past research in the field
- Write in various modes and from different points of view, including a position paper on teaching and using writing to improve instruction

Participants may receive **three undergraduate credits** in education from the UVA's College at Wise (the equivalent of 90 recertification points) **OR** a modest **stipend**. On-campus housing is available for the duration of the Institute.

AWP fellows are expected to continue forward with our site as an active member, participating in in-service and continuity events whenever possible. However, if you are interested in attending the Summer Institute for a certificate of attendance for recertification only, an invitation may be extended, but without the tuition scholarship, benefits, and expectations of Teacher Consultant (TC) membership.

TO APPLY: Please send the following information electronically. We *prefer* electronic submissions saved in .doc or .pdf format and attached to your email.

- One-page resume
- Letter of intent: 1-2 page typed letter explaining your interest in the Summer Institute and how it can benefit you, your colleagues, and your students. Also, please include a brief summary of a best teaching practice (with a focus on writing in your content) that you would like to develop into an in-service for teachers.
- One letter of recommendation from an administrator (may also be sent via email directly to Hope Cloud)
